This is a friendly reminder of Ohio's upcoming voting registration deadline on **Monday**, **October 7th**, the Voter Engagement Interns' Lowry tabling times, and Ohio early voting information.

Registering to vote and absentee ballot request forms:

To register to vote, you can visit the Voter Engagement Intern table in Lowry *before* Friday, October 4th. You will need the following information:

- Last 4 digits of SSN
- Name of your dorm (or home address if you live in Ohio)
- Box Number

The Interns will be at Lowry the following times:

- Monday, Wednesday, Friday: 12pm-1pm
- Tuesday: 11am-12pm
- Thursday: 10am-11am

You can also register online if you have an Ohio Driver's license or State ID: olvr.ohiosos.gov

The absentee ballot request application is due on <u>October 29th</u>. However, please **do not** wait for this deadline.

- You can receive and fill out an <u>absentee ballot request form</u> from the Voter Engagement Intern table in Lowry from now until Tuesday, October 29th. You can also fill it out <u>online</u> and then print it
- You then need to mail it back OR take it to the Board of Elections OR place it in the secure drop box outside the Board of Elections

Early Voting Information:

Ohio early voting starts <u>Tuesday, October 8th</u>: If you vote in person—whether early or on Election Day—you will need a photo I.D.

- Monday, Oct 21st to Friday, Oct 25th: 8am-6pm

- Monday, Oct 28th: 7:30am 7:30pm
- Tuesday, Oct 29th: 7:30am 8:30pm
- Wednesday Oct 30th to Friday Nov 1st: 7:30am 7:30pm

- Saturday, Nov 2nd: 8am 4pm
- Last Day of Early voting: Sunday, Nov 3rd: 1pm 5pm

Types of valid photo ID

- Ohio driver's license;
- State of Ohio ID card;
- Interim ID form issued by the Ohio BMV;
- A US passport;
- A US passport card;
- US military ID card;
- Ohio National Guard ID card; or
- US Department of Veterans Affairs ID card (physical or digital copy)

All photo IDs must have the following:

- An expiration date that has not passed;
- A photograph of the voter;
- The voter's name, which must substantially conform to the voter's name as it appears in the poll List or in the poll book

NOTICE: An unexpired Ohio Driver License, State ID Card, or Interim Documentation with your **former address IS an ACCEPTABLE** form of ID when your current address is in the pollbook.
